The Nelson Mandela University Research Entities are flagship structures that position and brand the University's research activities nationally and globally. They are key drivers of the university's vision and strategy, with their activities spanning and integrating the core University missions. They are critical in the University's pursuit impactful research, innovation and internationalisation to promote sustainable futures.

The key positioning messages of the University find expression in the institutional Vision 2030 and include firmly establishing the institution as a University that advances social justice in the service of society; repositioning and changing the face of engagement to respond to the key challenges of our time and space; revitalisation of the Humanities; being deliberate about pursuing transdisciplinary perspectives in our scholarly endeavours; expanding our African footprint; and growing and nurturing our institutional research themes as well as continuing to strengthen the University research outputs.

Nelson Mandela University Research Themes that are anchored by the work of the research entities are:

- Ocean and Coastal Sciences
- Social Justice and Democracy
- Environmental Stewardship and Sustainable Livelihoods
- Innovation and the Digital Economy
- Origins, Culture, Heritage and Memory

The University boasts 22 research entities which are divided into institutes (4), centres (12) and units (6). Working with academic departments, research chairs and faculties, the entities contribute significantly to the areas of postgraduate training, mentoring of postdoctoral and research fellows, research and engagement.
